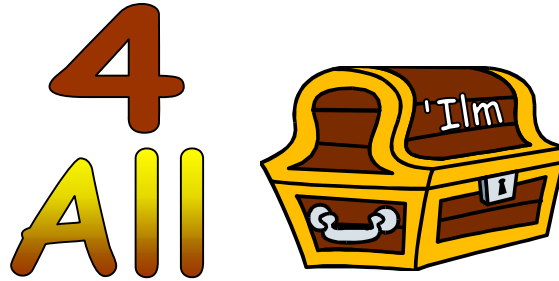

The Whole *Sunnah* Demonstrates *Tawheed*

The Noble Scholar Muhammad Ibn Saalih al-'Uthaymeen *rahimahullaah*, said (meaning of translation):¹

"...So the Prophet, *sallallaahu 'alayhi wa-sallam*, explained the whole of the Religion of Islaam through his sayings, his actions, and his tacit approvals, either to begin with, or in response to a question.

And the greatest of all the affairs which he made clear (through his sayings, actions and tacit approvals), is *Tawheed*."

² Transcriber's note: The people possessing the greatest, most correct understanding of the Qur'aan and *Sunnah* and that of *Tawheed*, are the *Sahaabah* - the favoured Companions of the Prophet. This is proven by many statements of the Prophet, *sallallaahu 'alayhi wa-sallam*, such as his saying: '**...whoever lives long from amongst you will see great controversy and disunity. So stick to what you know of my *Sunnah*, and the *Sunnah* of the orthodox rightly guided caliphs...**' [Reported by Ahmad and others: *hasan*]. The Companions were rightly guided because they learnt the Religion directly from the Prophet who affirmed their understanding and application of it. It is therefore obligatory upon us to understand and apply the Qur'aan and the *Sunnah* to our lives, just as the *Sahaabah* understood and applied them, so that we can become people of *Tawheed* and salvation.
